

“Food for Fines” Drive February 1st-28<sup>st</sup>



The Kingsville Public Library will be hosting a “Food for Fines” program from February 1<sup>st</sup>-February 28<sup>th</sup>. Patrons can wipe out their late fines while supporting their neighborhood food bank. For each donated non-perishable food item, paper product, or personal care item, the patron will have \$2.00 erased from any current outstanding fines. Fines and lost fees will also be waived when long overdue items are returned in good condition.

The most needed donations include paper products, toiletries, laundry care, and home care products like towels and can openers. These items are usually in a very low supply.
